### **Minutes**

December 18, 2025 BOT Meeting Minutes

Trustee Horning made a motion to approve the December 18, 2025 minutes as presented. Trustee Baldwin seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.



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### DPW/Village Administrator Report Updates –

Lakeport Road Sewer District – At the Town Board meeting yesterday (January 21<sup>st</sup>) it was announced that they are tentatively moving forward. Trustee Kopp asked Mr. Freunsch to give the meeting attendees an overview of the project. Mr. Freunsch advised that Barton & Loguidice will be providing a quote to perform an analysis of the Village’s sewer treatment plant to make sure it can handle the additional flow. The plant is currently at 50% capacity. Headloading still needs to be done. This could potentially lower the Village sewer rates.

Creekwalk Section III – Mr. Freunsch updated everyone regarding the status of the DEC permit needed for the tree removal (as it pertains to protection of the Indiana Bats). The trees need to be removed by March 31<sup>st</sup> or the tree removal will have to be postponed until November.

Powell Lacrosse – an upcoming event in Stooks Park February 1<sup>st</sup> 8:00Am-2:00PM; Morrisville students will be on hand to assist; Powell’s EMTs will be onsite; there will be a fee charged for use of the Park.

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### Village Administrator

- (1) Review Parts 1, 2 and 3 of Short EAF and Adopt Resolution Determining That the Proposed Creek Walk Phase III Project is an Unlisted Action and Will Not Have a Significant Adverse Impact on the Environment

Trustee Kopp made a motion to adopt the Resolution Determining That the Proposed Creek Walk Phase III Project is an Unlisted Action and Will Not Have a Significant Adverse Impact on the Environment and authorize Mayor Cianfrocco to sign the Resolution. Trustee Horning seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

- (2) Review 2026-2027 Budget Calendar

Mr. Freunsch advised that worksheets will be distributed to department heads to begin the process for the 2026-2027 Budget.

- (3) Discuss Celebrating Nation's 250<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

Mr. Freunsch advised that the Village is considering preparing a Time Capsule to celebrate America's 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary. It will be tied in with Tuesdays in the Park – either the Tuesday before July 4<sup>th</sup> or the Tuesday after. Fireworks may be part of the celebration. Trustee Wehner suggested getting all the non-profit organizations involved.

- (4) Intermunicipal Agreement with Village of Minoa

The Village has enlisted the assistance of the Clerk-Treasurer from the Village of Minoa to properly train staff in the municipal accounting system. The Village of Chittenango will pay for her time spent training and reimbursement for mileage. The Village of Minoa will continue to pay her benefits. Mr. Freunsch requested that the Board authorize Mayor Cianfrocco to sign the intermunicipal agreement with the Village of Minoa. Attorney Bell recommended that a term expiring 12/31/2026 be included in the agreement. Trustee Kopp made a motion to authorize the Mayor to sign such intermunicipal agreement. Trustee Wehner seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

### Old Business

Confirm Harboring Hens Permit – 230 Seneca Street

Trustee Baldwin made a motion to accept the existing survey of the property since requesting a new survey would be a hardship for the property owners. Trustee Kopp seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

### Any Other Business That May Come Before the Board

Mr. Freunsch advised that the Town is working on amending Veterans' exemptions. Parameters are defined by the federal government. The Village will mirror what the Town prepares. A joint statement regarding the exemptions and how to apply for them will be in the April newsletter.
